POULTRY FACTS

Poultry are domesticated birds raised for food, such as chickens, turkeys, ducks and geese. Chicken, turkey, and ducks are among the most widely distributed food animals in the world and are part of every major cuisine.

As a rule of thumb, four ounces of skinless, boneless chicken will serve one adult, while a whole chicken will serve approximately one person per pound. For a whole turkey, figure on one pound per person.
